Report on 3-Days National Workshop on
Learning Outcomes: Formulation, Mapping &
Assessment

October 26, 2024 to October 28, 2024

## **Executive Summary**

The Association of Indian Universities-Dayalbagh Educational Institute-Academic and Administrative Development Center (AIU-DEI-AADC) in association with the Faculty of Education, DEI organized a 3-Day National Workshop on Learning Outcomes: Formulation, Mapping, and Assessment from October 26-28, 2024.

The workshop aimed to equip educators, curriculum developers, and academic professionals with practical skills to design and assess meaningful learning outcomes. Participants gained insights into formulating clear, measurable outcomes aligned with course objectives, mapping them across curricula, and implementing effective assessment strategies. The sessions emphasized Outcome Based Education (OBE) principles, fostering a student-centered learning approach. The comprehensive course content featured six sessions expertly crafted by six resource persons. A total of one hundred and thirty-three participants from diverse locations attended the workshop in a blended mode.


presentation enabled participants to acquire a more profound understanding of Bloom's Taxonomy and its practical applications across different educational levels.





During the second session of day one, Prof. N.P.S. Chandel, Dean of the Faculty of Education at DEI, shared valuable insights on how to formulate learning outcomes that are measurable, achievable, and observable. He emphasized key strategies for writing objectives in behavioral terms, guiding attendees to craft clear and effective learning goals.






On the second day, the discussion focused on the mapping of learning outcomes. Professor Gursaran from the Department of Mathematics at the Faculty of Science, DEI, presented on the topic of outcome-based education. He elaborated on the importance of aligning educational outcomes with learning experiences and assessment methods. Additionally, he underscored the significance of using assessment rubrics. The session proved to be both insightful and highly relevant.





In the next session, Professor Ajay Surana, the Head of the Department of Education at Banasthali Vidyapeeth in Rajasthan, focused on the intricacies of formulating course outcomes (COs) and program outcomes (POs). He provided detailed examples to illustrate these concepts and explored the CO-PO matrix. The session emphasized the importance of mapping and assessing POs, program educational objectives (PEOs), and COs, which were highlighted as key points of discussion.





On the third day of the program, the focus was directed towards program objectives and outcomes. Professor R.S. Pavithra, Professor and Director at Hindustan College of Science & Technology in Mathura, delivered a comprehensive discussion on the subject of program

objectives and outcomes, incorporating a model for outcome-based evaluation. He also emphasized the significance of competencies and performance indicators concerning these outcomes.

The six technical sessions were conducted under the supervision of a distinguished panel of chairpersons, which included Professor Nandita Satsangee, Professor Lajwanti, Professor P.S. Tyagi, Professor Meenu Singh, Dr. Sona Dixit, and Dr. C.L. Singh from the Faculty of Education at the Dayalbagh Educational Institute.





During the closing session, Professor Nandita Satsangee extended a cordial welcome to the distinguished guests in attendance. Professor Kavita Sharma, from the Department of Elementary Education at NCERT, New Delhi, delivered the valedictory address. The workshop report was presented by Dr. Anjana Verma, the co-convener of the workshop.
